The new 10th U.S. District GOP Executive Committee had a meeting on **January 12**, **2012** in Greensboro. District Chairman Brian Burdette is continuing efforts to organize the new District in preparation for the conventions and elections. The cost for the District Convention will be \$ 30.00 in Greensboro at the Spotlight Theater. It will include a continental breakfast and a lunch buffet.

The State Party has announced a joint effort with CNN to broadcast a GOP Presidential Candidate Forum on Thursday, **March 1, 2012**, prior to our Georgia GOP Presidential Preference Primary election on Tuesday, **March 6, 2012**.

Authorities can check for address updates and take corrective action, if needed, to make sure our local voter roll is correct.

We had a great meeting last month with good attendance. Stephen Simpson of Milledgeville spoke to us about his campaign for the new 10^{th} U.S. Congressional seat. The 2012 Convention Call was issued with Precinct Delegate allocations. We also reviewed the delegate breakdown for the 25 counties in the new 10^{th} U.S. District for the District Convention in April.

Our next regular monthly meeting will be Monday, **February 20, 2012** at 7:30 PM in the Winder Woman's Club. Our speaker will be current 10th U.S. District Rep. Paul Broun who is running for the new 10th U.S. Congressional seat this year. There will be a signup list circulated (non-binding) of those members who want to be considered to serve as Delegates and/or Alternates to the 2012 District Convention (**April 14**) in Greensboro and State Convention in Columbus (**May 18-19**). [Final determination will be made at our County Convention on **March 10** by the convention delegates.] Applications for official absentee ballots for the **March 6** election will be available, too. ABBREVIATED CALL FOR THE BARROW COUNTY REPUBLICAN ELECTION DISTRICT (PRECINCT) MASS MEETINGS

PRECINCT MASS MEETINGS

Pursuant to the Call of the Georgia Republican State Executive Committee for Precinct, Rule 9.2 District, County, Congressional District, and State Mass Meetings and Conventions, the Barrow County Republican Committee hereby makes and issues this, the Official Call, to all legal and qualified voters of Barrow County, Georgia, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, believe in its declaration of policies and are in sympathy with its aims and purposes, to unite under this Call in the selection of Delegates and Alternates to the Barrow County Convention to be held pursuant to this Call. There shall be Election District (Precinct) Mass Meetings on March 10, 2012 at 9:00 o'clock A.M. at 15 W. Midland Ave., Winder, Georgia, at the Winder Woman's Club, which shall elect Delegates and Alternates to the County Convention to be held on March 12, 2012, at same location. Registration begins at 8:00 o'clock A.M. on March 12, 2012. Anyone arriving after 9:00 A.M. will not be allowed to participate.

COUNTY CONVENTION

The Barrow County Convention is hereby called to convene at 15 W. Midland Ave., Winder, Georgia, at the Winder Woman's Club on Saturday, March 10, 2012, at 10:00 o'clock A.M., for the purpose of electing Delegates and Alternates to the Tenth U.S. Congressional District and State Conventions. Only those Delegates and Alternates elected in the respective Election District (Precinct) Mass Meetings held on March 10, 2012, shall be entitled to participate. The Convention itself shall be open to the public.

A certain Mr. Obama Onyango was arrested on August 24 outside a fried-chicken shop in Framingham, Mass. WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE 2012 PRECINCT MEETINGS AND COUNTY CONVENTION

Many of our newer members may not be aware of the significance of the upcoming Precinct Mass Meetings and County Convention set for Saturday, **March 10, 2012** at the Winder Woman's Club, 15 W. Midland Ave.

At 9:00 AM on March 10, 2012, Precinct Chairpersons or Temporary Precinct Meeting Chairpersons will call the 16 individual precinct meetings to order. All participants at these meetings must be duly registered in accordance with State Republican Party rules and Georgia State Election Code. Precincts without Chairpersons will elect these officers. All Precinct Chairpersons will then conduct the rest of the precinct meetings. Each precinct meeting will elect delegates and alternates to the 2012 Barrow County Republican Convention. All delegates will receive name tags for Convention usage.

When all of this is completed, the paperwork (in triplicate) will be processed and routed to the appropriate local Party representatives. Other precinct business may take place at this meeting.

At 10:00 AM on **March 10**, the current local Party Chairman Ken young will call the 2012 County Convention to order. After the Pledge of Allegiance, Invocation, Presentation of the State Call, and Introduction of Dignitaries, Convention committees will be appointed and dismissed to conduct their work (Credentials, Nominations, Rules). During this time, there will be announcements and speeches in the convention hall.

After the Convention committees return and report, the Convention will then elect delegates and alternates to the 10th U.S. Congressional District Republican Convention to be held Saturday, **April 14, 2012** (Greensboro). Delegates and alternates will also be elected to the State Republican Convention to be held Friday and Saturday, **May 18-19, 2012** in Columbus, Muscogee County, Georgia.

At the District/State Conventions, delegates and alternates will be elected to the Republican National Convention, Monday through Thursday, **August 31-September 3, 2012**, in Tampa, Florida, to nominate the next Republican President.

Fail. A 10 percent tax on indoor tanning services instituted July 1, 2010, has backfired.
