# IS THE LOCAL REPUBLICAN PARTY DYING, OR AM I LOSING MY MIND?

My 62-year-old hurt right knee talked to me all night long. Pain meds helped little. My lower back was so tight, I could not walk upright very well. It seemed like every joint ached. If you had asked me, my reply would have been, "Yes, it feels like someone turned me upside down, and beat my bare feet with a hammer."

Such is a part of the aftermath of working our annual Barrow Republican BBQ. There are other volunteers who experienced similar woes. This event and other local Republican activities would never fly, if we did not have such dedicated unsung heroes. God bless them all! I appreciate every one of them.

The problem is this. There are not enough other folks willing to help them (even occasionally), the ones who do step up to the plate are getting older and weaker, and their numbers get smaller every year. It will only get worse, as we all approach death, as we live another day closer to eternity.

We dodged a bullet on August 23, 2014. Our treasurer/ticket man was still recovering from a stroke. Our chairman cautiously avoided moves with his back and legs which could have immobilized him. If any of our servers had gone down, our number of backups was slim. Help from 4 UGA College Republicans got us through another BBQ in ticket checking and filling drinks. Yet we almost did not have them this year, because most of the CRs were working on individual campaigns.

There is a great temptation for the few worn-out workers to hang it up. If they do, the current Barrow County Republican Party's effectiveness is dead. In the future, a BCRP may continue to be the qualifying agent for candidates wanting to run for office. The influence we have now will disappear, if more local Republicans fail to step in and work to keep things going in the right direction.

We are not alone. People are seeing similar problems in other groups like civic clubs, churches, etc. 10 percent do 90 percent of the work, and 100 percent claim the credit. "Misery loves company." It still does not make it right.

The official worrier rejoices when he sees actual people entering the Lions Club on BBQ day. He is reminded yearly by others that everything will work out, and it does. If a problem arises, veteran BBQ staff get it done. For 8 years, it has been my privilege and pleasure to feel like a general watching our troops secure successful victory. Our success comes from our team approach and implementation. What is going to happen when there is no team left?

Membership trends listed on the first page of this newsletter are not encouraging. Whether someone blames us for the RNC or GWB or BHO or amnesty, and quits, or whether we are victims of our own success, or whatever, younger and other folks have got to take up the challenge. My time is numbered. Since 1994, except for 2 years, this has been my second full time job. My earthly tabernacle can not continue with the same load. I will help where I can.

What will YOU do? Do you believe our guiding conservative principles enough to DO something? "Faith without works is dead."

You've heard me describe Obama the theoretician, sipping cocktails and pontificating in the Ivy League faculty lounge. Obama and his ilk have zero real-world experience, but they think they know how to run everything due to their innate superiority. They truly believe this. Meanwhile the world explodes, because the so-called smartest people in the room . . . aren't.

Well, I was even more right than I knew. A stunning 9/5/13 piece in *The Wall Street Journal* reports that Russia moved two warships, two support vessels, and three amphibious troop and equipment movers off the Syrian coast. Russian satellites and radar sites are feeding Syria intelligence on U.S. military movement. Oh, and on top pf the "arsenal of advanced Russian-made weapons systems, including a recent shipment of upgraded Yakhont anti-ship missiles" delivered to Assad already, Russia promised Syria "advanced S-300 air-defense systems." Which could, as *The Journal* puts it, "shift the regional military balance." No kidding, Sherlock.

Have you heard any of this? Of course not. The media is too busy sitting at Obama's feet to report Russian military moves. Because Reagan and Bush were the warmonger bloodthirsty cowboys bumbling into war, and Obama is genius Professor Peacenik.
