The seventh Planned Parenthood video should have been a bombshell. Former StemExpress employee Holly O’Donnell, who has appeared in several of the videos released by the Center for Medical Progress, describes how a technician at Planned Parenthood Mar Monte’s Alameda Clinic in San Jose, Calif., showed her the still-beating heart of an aborted baby (“kinda cool,” the technician calls it), then ordered O’Donnell to harvest the brain – a procedure that requires her to “cut down the middle of the baby’s face.” (Adds O’Donnell, rightly: “I can’t even describe what that feels like.”) Assuming this account is accurate, Planned Parenthood violated state and federal laws; in fact, it committed out-and-out murder, since the definition of “human being” in both the state and federal criminal codes applies to an *ex utero* infant with a heartbeat. It will come as no surprise that major outlets – to name just a few: the *New York Times*, the *Washington Post*, ABC, NBC, CBS – had carried no news of the video 24 hours later. They have demonstrated no interest in investigating these grave charges, nor has the current administration. The refusal of both to do so is a disgrace almost as shameful as the one they’re ignoring. Kids caught with a hand in the cookie jar typically deny and lie. Same with libs. This time the cookie jar is the left's crusade against the Confederate flag. And one of their own had a hand in it. According to *The New York Post*, tiles depicting the Rebel flag were installed more than 90 years ago in the Times Square subway station. The original purpose: to honor Adolph S. Ochs, then-publisher of *The New York Times* – and, yes, Rebel sympathizer. Ochs' mother, Bertha, was a charter member of the United Daughters of the Confederacy, who helped to smuggle spies during the Civil War. Of course, this historical fact is totally inconvenient in uber-left New York City. Indeed, the big Apple's MTA denies any connection between the Confederate tiles and the Confederate flag. Waving his magic liberal dismissal wand, MTA spokesman Kevin Ortiz explains the stars-and-bars tiling is “a geometric pattern, not a flag design, and has no reference to anything beyond a pattern.” Who are you gonna believe, the MTA, or your lynin' eyes? The Iran deal keeps getting worse. The Associated Press obtained the text of a “side agreement” between Iran and the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) that purports to allow Iran to inspect itself at the crucial Parchin nuclear site. This new revelation compounds the flaws of the main agreement, which already rejected “anytime, anywhere” inspections in favor of a process that gives Iran written notice of intention to inspect, followed by a weeks-long dispute-resolution process in the event that Iran objects. It is increasingly clear that there is no “deal” in the Iran deal, merely capitulation to a sworn enemy. (*National Review*)
