# PLANNED PARENTHOOD BLATANTLY TARGETS MINORITY WOMEN

On October 31, 2017, Planned Parenthood tweeted, "If you're a Black woman in America, it's statistically safer to have an abortion than to carry a pregnancy to term or give birth."

Margaret Sanger, founder of PP, stated in 1926 that "colored people are like weeds and are to be exterminated." Ninety-one years later, the abortion giant continues to target racial minorities. In 2012, 79% of PP's surgical abortion clinics were located within walking distance of African American or Hispanic/Latino neighborhoods. And the targeting has accelerated with Planned Parenthood's 23 mega centers built since 2004. Alarmingly, 88% (22 of 25) of them target women of color.

## IT SNOWED IN THE SAHARA DESERT

It's quite a time for weird weather, and it doesn't get much weirder than snow falling in one of the hottest places in the world

On Sunday [1/7/18 – KY], Ain Sefra, a desert town in Algeria known as the "Gateway to the Sahara," experienced a substantial amount of snow for reportedly the third time in 40 years. Some reports say parts of the area got nearly 15 inches of snow, but Ain Sefra officially reported less than one inch.

Now, it's not uncommon for the temperature across even the hottest of deserts to plunge tens of degrees Farenheit at night, meaning any unusual snow could stick around for a while. But photographers at the scene said the snow actually stayed intact for a good portion of the day.

The United Kingdom's process of saying goodbye to the European Union has been getting nowhere because the Europeans are insisting that the U.K. pay tens of billions of pounds to Brussels. This is partly to honor commitments made in the past, partly to intimidate other countries that might also want to exit, and partly to punish the U.K. for its temerity. Prime Minister Theresa May has the unenviable task of squaring the circle with squabbling cabinet ministers and the Brussels official team. She chose Florence as the city in which to deliver what she hoped was a make-or-break speech, or, in plain language, a concession to demands. Brussels will get the billions of pounds, EU citizens already in the U.K. will have the right to stay, and the agreed transition period is to be extended by two years. Brexiteers suspect that her heart isn't really in leaving, although one of her sentences does speak for them: "The EU never felt to us like an integral part of our national story." (National Review)

## BI-POLAR BEARS

For decades leftists have raised money off a myth – that cute, gentle polar bears are vanishing from the planet. Ads feature crying orphan polar cubs, mournful polar bears stranded on a chunk of ice, cuddly polar bears drowning in "warming" seas.

All because you drive an SUV and have air conditioning. Well, apparently that tactic stopped working, because now the bears are being rebranded as horrible predators headed straight to your front door.

According to *The Washington Post*, "Polar bears hurt by climate change are more likely to turn to a new food source – humans." Yes, government wildlife researchers warn that the higher global temperatures go, "the more likely polar bears are to interact with humans – and possibly attack and eat them." Apparently, there were 15 bear attacks in Arctic field camps and towns between 2010-14. Which isn't really news, as bears have attacked humans since the beginning of time.

Here's what you need to, well, bear in mind. The polar bear population, despite the fundraising blather, has actually been growing by leaps and bounds. As reported by Polar Bear Science, in 2005 there were 22,500; by 2015 the population had surged to 28,500. ## ABORTION NUMBERS STEADILY DECREASING

The Centers for Disease Control released a November 2017 report citing 2014 abortion rates (*most recent available*) in the U.S. According to CDC, abortion in the U.S. had fallen to its lowest rate of occurrence since 1971, when it was legal in only six states. From 2013 to 2014 alone, the numbers dropped 2%.

However, while CDC request abortion data from the central health agencies of every state, as well as the District of Columbia and New York City, the federal government does not require that the agencies report. Therefore, CDC figure run short. For instance, in 2014, CDC received data from 49 reporting areas rather than 52.

According to their numbers, abortion rates have not been lower since 1975, just two years after *Roe v. Wade*, the Supreme Court case that brought about legal abortion nationwide.

# EXXON CLAIMS CALIFORNIA CLIMATE CHANGE HYPOCRISY

ExxonMobil is trying to turn the tables on its climate change opponents.

The oil company said it's a victim of a vast "conspiracy," brought on by multiple cities and counties in California.

San Francisco, Oakland and other municipalities have sued Exxon, demanding the oil giant and its rivals pay billions to cover damage from looming sea level rise due to climate change.

In a court filing in Texas on Monday, Exxon argued that these California cities and counties have contradicted themselves by admitting in bond sales that climate change risks are unpredictable. Exxon threatened a counter-lawsuit over allege "abuse of government power."

Exxon said that while these cities and towns warned that "imminent sea level rise presented a substantial threat to its jurisdiction . . . none of the municipalities disclosed to investors such risks."

A California woman, Mariza Ruelas, was recently summoned to court for an unlikely crime: selling a plate of ceviche. Ruelas was a member of a community Facebook group, "209 Food Spot," which allows residents of Stockton, Calif., to organize potluck meals, share recipes, and sell or exchange food. As a hobby, the mother of six began to trade or give away meals via the group, and in July she was summoned to court on the charges of operating a food facility and engaging in business without a permit, after an undercover investigator ordered ceviche from her as part of a sting. Ruelas refused a plea deal and now is headed to trial, facing up to one year in jail. (National Review)

## FBI CONSIDERING CRIMINAL PROBE OF PLANNED PARENTHOOD

The FBI is reviewing recommendations to investigate evidence related to Planned Parenthood's trade of aborted baby organs and body parts.

In May, leaders of 15 life affirming groups representing millions of Americans wrote a letter to Attorney General Jeff Sessions and then-acting FBI director Andrew McCabe asking for the investigation, based on a deluge of video evidence released by Center for Medical Progress.

The letter said, "The facts uncovered raise a reasonable suspicion that these organizations, and/or individuals employed by them, may have engaged in a conspiracy to violate the fetal tissue law."

In addition, the Senate Judiciary Committee and the U.S. House Select Panel on Infant lives both recommended the FBI investigate and possibly file criminal charges against Planned Parenthood after their own 2015 investigation.

#### FAKE NEWS, THE CHICAGO WAY

The University of Chicago is having trouble recruiting, as toptier students are worried about the Second City's reputation as the First City of Crime.
