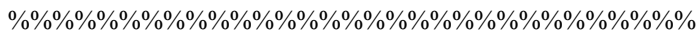

- Travel restrictions have not been lifted, but if you come across our southern border, come one, come all with no restrictions
- Any conservative gathering will at any time be categorized as a “superspreader event,” but any riot, protest or gathering of liberals, progressives, socialists, communists, antifa, etc. is okay because “social justice” or whatever
- Mask mandates are probably coming again soon, but Nancy Pelosi can invoke one for the House floor and office building and while announcing it – on the House floor! – not wear one
- Gun control is again a hot topic in Washington DC, but if you are related to the president, break any gun law you want and the Secret Service will intervene on your behalf

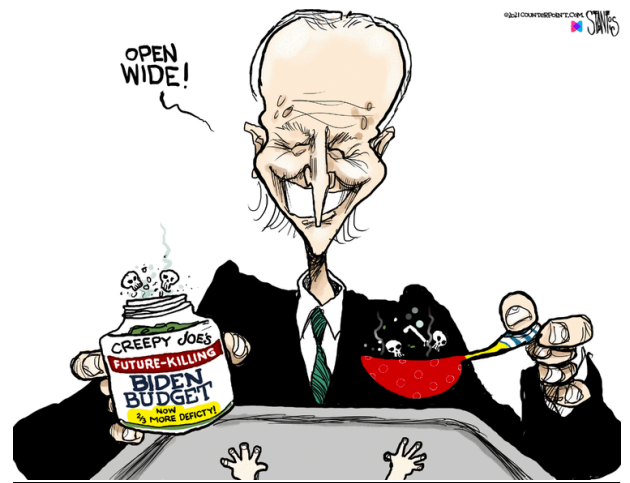

**STEPS FOR POLITICAL CHANGE**

1. To change things, you have to change the laws.
2. To change the laws, you must change the people who make the laws, either by influencing them to change their positions, or by removing them from office.
3. People who make the laws must be winning candidates in the general election.
4. To be a candidate on the general election ballot, that person is nominated for an office, usually by a Party primary election.
5. To win a Party primary election, a candidate has to win a majority of the Party primary election ballots for his or her race.
6. To win a majority of the Party primary election ballots, a candidate must campaign hard for those votes.
7. To campaign for election, a candidate must properly qualify With the Party in March or April before an even-year Primary election.
8. True Republicans must be recruited to qualify to run.
